WHERE?



There are two UHB nurseries. One based at the University Hospital of Wales, and the other based at the University Hospital Llandough.

WHO?

The Nurseries are open to all.

HOW MANY?



University Hospital of Wales: 60 places

9 Baby Bears (3 months - 18 months) 21 Little Bears (18 months - 2½ years) 30 Big Bears (2½ years - 5 years)

University Hospital Llandough: 33 places

9 Baby Bears (3 months - 18 months) 12 Little Bears (18 months - 2½ years) 12 Big Bears (2½ years - 5 years)

STAFFING STRUCTURE

The nurseries are staffed by Nursery Managers, a Deputy Manager, Team Leaders, Senior Nursery Nurse, Nursery Nurses, Nursery Practioners and Nursery Assistants



A Key Worker system is in place in all age groups in both nurseries to ensure continuity of care and effective communication.

PAYMENT - NURSERY FEES



Payment for Nursery fees will be made in the first instance by deduction from monthly salary or via a Standing Order for non-staff users.

ARRIVAL / DEPARTURE



The nurseries open at 8am. (A 7am start can be requested – extra charge applies) and close at 6pm. Parents should arrive by 5:45 to enable a thorough handover. Parents are expected to complete the arrival/departure documentation daily.

Late Collection:

The nursery closes at 6pm. Failure to collect your child by this time will incur a late fee. This situation will only be tolerated on 3 occasions before a review of the child's attendance is undertaken.

ROUTINES

During the nursery day, children will be encouraged to follow the routines of the nursery, which differ depending on the age and more importantly, the developmental stage of each child. However, the individual needs of children will be catered for whenever possible.

Settling In:

The nurseries offer a 'settling in' period of various sessions over 2 weeks free of charge. This is reviewed with the parent and Nursery Managers in relation to the child's individual needs.

ACTIVITIES
