Clinical Key

We regret to tell you that the subscription to Clinical Key ended on 31st May 2018.

When we took out the subscription in 2016 it was only for two years, and unfortunately no other funding has been found to continue the subscription.

We understand that Clinical Key has been popular amongst clinicians and we are sorry we have had to take this decision. However, we can offer some other options which may help to compensate:

UpToDate: we will continue to subscribe to UpToDate which provides evidence-based summaries of information about a particular condition, including symptoms, tests, diagnosis and treatment options. It also includes patient information material, drug interactions, calculators, practice changing updates, and a What's new feature. UpToDate is available through the UHB Clinical Portal, and we offer training sessions for departments.

Database (Medline) searches: Clinical Key included links to Medline: as a reminder, you can find Medline on the NHS Wales e-library, and we also offer a tailored literature search service which will provide a targeted set of references on your topic. We can then help you to find the full text of the articles you wish to see.

Inter-Library Loans: you can request any article or book through our Inter-Library Loan service, which is free of charge. Please ask for full details.
