# Did you know....?



### What is an Athens account?

An Athens account is a way of verifying that you are employed by the NHS in Wales, and that you are entitled to use the electronic resources which NHS Wales has paid for. You can register yourself for an account by following the links on the NHS Wales e-library web page, or for help contact Rosemary, who is the Athens Administrator for C&V UHB.

### How can I use my Athens account?

Your Athens username and password can only be used for the resources in the NHS Wales e-library. If you are using the e-library from home, you will be asked for your Athens details. If you are using it on a UHB PC, the resources should open without needing Athens.

### What is in the NHS Wales e-library?

The e-library has many useful sources of information, including Cochrane Library, databases, guidelines, BNF and the BNF app, plus around 370 electronic journals chosen for their clinical relevance. You can use the e-library on a UHB PC at: http://howis.wales.nhs.uk/ehl or at home at: http://www.wales.nhs.uk/ehl

### Where else can I find journal articles?

If you need articles which are not included in the e-library, you can request them from your site library, either in person or online at http://librarysearch.cardiff.ac.uk To request online, you will need to sign in with your library card number and a password, which can be obtained from the Health Library or the Archie Cochrane Library.

#### EDUCATIONAL CPD OPPORTUNITIES FOR TRAINERS

#### Background

In August 2012, the GMC released details of its new arrangements for the formal recognition of medical trainers in secondary care in a document entitled 'Recognising and Approving Trainers: The Implementation Plan'. As part of these arrangements trainers are required to demonstrate an ongoing commitment to their development as a medical educator by undertaking educational continuing professional development (CPD) and demonstrating appropriate attitudes and behaviours.

#### Trainer and Educator Development Days: 2013 - 2016

#### History

The Wales Deanery, in conjunction with Cardiff University School of Medicine and College of Medicine, Swansea University, developed the Trainer and Educator Development Days (TEDD) in 2013 as a mechanism for publicising the importance of professionalisation of trainer roles and to provide a forum and community of practice for trainers to share ideas and good practice.

The events were delivered by experts in medical education and training, and themes included the 'Learning Environment' and 'Innovative Practices in Medical Education'.

The TEDDs have been held in high esteem, with over 2000 trainers attending in total over four years. Each event has been over-subscribed, demonstrating their continued popularity. This reflects a real desire among trainers to develop as individuals and professionalise the role.

#### Sharing Training Excellence in Medical Education (STEME) Conference

In order to address the feedback above, in 2017 the Deanery will be piloting a two-day conference (in place of the TEDDs). The **Sharing Training Excellence in Medical Education** (STEME) Conference will be held at the Liberty Stadium, Swansea on the dates below:

Day 1: 'Organisational Culture' – Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2017 Day 2: 'Supporting and Developing Learners' – Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September 2017

The conference will provide delegates with the latest information and newest developments in medical education and training as well as practical ideas to improve their educational practice. The programme will provide substantial time for networking and will consist of stimulating **keynotes** as well as a diverse range of **practical and interactive professional development workshops**. Content will be mapped to the GMC's Framework Areas and will be accredited for CPD points.

The conference will be open to the four categories of trainer requiring recognition by the GMC, i.e. Educational Supervisors, Named Clinical Supervisors, Lead Co-ordinators of undergraduate training at Local Education Providers (LEP), and Doctors responsible for overseeing students' educational progress for medical schools. Each day will accommodate 300 delegates.

The keynote and plenary sessions for each day will be recorded and made available online as a certificated package for those unable to attend the events in person, thus maximising access to the CPD whilst minimising service disruption.

#### Local CPD Opportunities

A number of local and external CPD opportunities are available to trainers, and the Deanery is working with LEPs to ensure that these opportunities are expanded and signposted effectively.

A newsletter will be circulated quarterly by the Deanery, informing trainers of upcoming CPD opportunities across Wales.
