The feedback will enable us to continue to work with the Welsh Government and NHS Wales to ensure trainers are supported in their roles and ensure we are effectively implementing the GMC's Trainer Recognition Strategy. In addition, you can use the completion reference number as evidence of your commitment to participating in systems of quality assurance and quality improvement in your appraisal.

Who is this relevant for?

The survey is relevant for the following groups:-

- ⇒ Educational Supervisors: In secondary care this refers to those who have signed up to the Educational Supervision Agreement and in primary care this refers to GP Trainers.
- ⇒ Named Clinical Supervisors: Those Clinical Supervisors who oversee a trainees' work throughout the post and are involved in progress decisions.
