

LGBT adoption & fostering week

Record numbers of LGBT people in the UK now consider adoption and fostering, but many more are needed to parent vulnerable children. **LGBT Adoption & Fostering Week – the annual campaign encouraging LGBT people in the UK to explore these parenting routes.**

Research consistently shows that LGBT people expect to face discrimination because of their sexual orientation or gender identity when applying to adopt or foster, so the campaign unites agencies keen to work with LGBT applicants and New Family Social, the UK's charity for LGBT adopters and foster carers. **Throughout the week a series of 60 information events across Britain is planned by adoption and foster care agencies for LGBT people**, including a dog walk in Scotland, a drop-in at Wrexham's WaterWorld and **seminars in central London and Manchester.**
