Children's Cancer Care - Sierra Leone

There is a long way to go to develop a full children's cancer service however many children are being treated and helped."

The children are treated at Ola During Children's Hospital in Freetown, the capital of Sierra Leone. Ola During Children's Hospital is the only designated government children's hospital in Sierra Leone
