

Access and entry points to the UHW site

Entry points:

- East bound entrance from Gabalfa Flyover
- Allensbank Road East
- Slip Road off Eastern Avenue (A48)

Exit points:

- You can exit the site via King George V Drive West
- Allensbank Road East
- Slip Road off Eastern Avenue (A48)

You will no longer be able to drive past the Emergency Unit (EU). Only Emergency Vehicles and Public Transport will have access to this area.

If you need to access the EU please enter at one of the following:

- East bound entrance from the Gabalfa fly over and park in the small multi storey car park or turn left and park behind the Dental Hospital (adjacent to A48)
- Allensbank Road and park in the multi storey car park
- Slip Road off Eastern Avenue (A48) and park in the multi storey car park.

Cardiff and Vale UHB has unveiled new traffic measures on its University Hospital of Wales site

Changes are being made to ease the flow of traffic around the site to ensure all site users, patients, staff, visitors and contractors, can access the areas they need, when they need them and that vitally no patient comes to harm as a result of restricted traffic flow and congestion.

A recent survey told us:

- 16,000+ vehicles access the UHW site every day
- 7,600 vehicles use the UHW site as a cut through
- 47.5% of all vehicles not using UHB services
- 9% increase in traffic volume on the UHW site since 2014.

The Health Board proposes to improve the traffic on UHW site by making two major changes:

- No throughway access to the road running adjacent to entrance of the Emergency Unit except for emergency vehicles and public transport
- The entrance to King George V Drive (West) will only be available for emergency vehicles and public transport; you will only be able to exit the site via King George V Drive (West).
